SOUP LUNCH. SUNDAY 24th MARCH

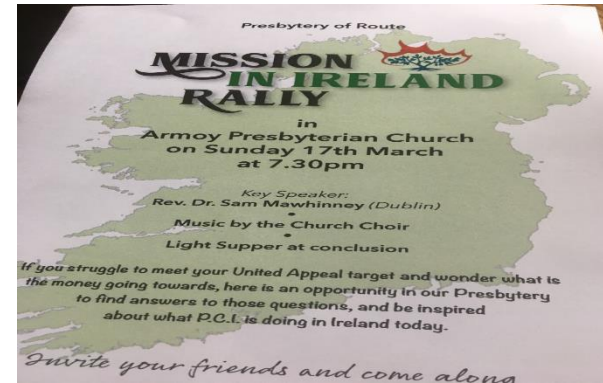
