Where and what is this?

Violet and Rosemary Hunter have planted 2 acres of sunflowers and 300 pumpkins on the family farm at 97, Causeway Road Bushmills in aid of 3 charities which are The Smiles Foundation Romania, Cancer research UK, and Laurel House Antrim. All monies raised will be split evenly between them.

Why sunflowers?
